Reading Activity	Project format
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read a novel where the main character is not human</li> <li>• Read a collection of poetry (at least 10 poems)</li> <li>• Read a biography</li> <li>• Read a daily newspaper for 2 weeks</li> <li>• Read a book by someone outside of the UK</li> <li>• Read a graphic novel</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create a speech about an issue raised in your reading</li> <li>• Create a blog about the author/topics/characters you have read about</li> <li>• Write a letter to the writer that interested you most to ask questions and explain what you enjoyed</li> <li>• Create a vlog/animation surrounding a theme or issue that interested you</li> <li>• Re-create the front cover and a possible movie poster for your reading</li> </ul>
