



### Catch Up Premium Spending 2019-2020

The Catch Up Premium is awarded by the government to support students who arrive at Bishop Milner with less than expected attainment in English and Maths or both.

The figure we received for the academic year 2019-2020 was £7174

This money was spent on supporting students in the following ways.

Summer School for students joining the college with low Literacy and Numeracy skills.

#### Literacy

The purchase of reading strategy materials for students identified as having a low reading age.

Access Reading Test credits to monitor the impact of the interventions.

TA support time to deliver sessions for students in years 7 and 8.

#### Numeracy

The purchase of Numeracy Catch Up workbooks to provide the resources for intervention.

Access Maths Test credits to monitor the impact of interventions.

TA support time to deliver sessions for students in year 7 and 8.

In addition a TA was trained in both Catch Up Literacy and Numeracy Programmes and is running sessions on a 1-1 basis with our weakest students in year 7, 8 and 9.
