



**The curriculum for this stage of students' education has been designed to** develop knowledge of various health services, including those in the NHS. In Unit 2 students will use knowledge of the care values and services, studied at KS4, to identify the aims of services within the health and social care sector. Students will also explore various laws and legislations, which will be supported by RE and History. In Unit 11 students will learn about the core psychological perspectives, and will be using knowledge to apply to case studies behaviour. Students will investigate a range of mental illnesses and look at how treatments could be used to support individuals.
